Give every chance that you get, make it a habit; give until you feel that you can give no more and God will lift you up to do much greater things. Every time you do something gracious for

someone, you do it to God, and God keeps records on everything. This is a great method of service to God, as you give to those less fortunate. Then, once you are proven worthy in lesser things God entrusts you with larger things, and as a result you are lifted up and you raise others up along with you.

There is no way to out-give God; He owns everything and can give it to whom He wishes, and he gives gifts to those that He knows will use them for His glory and honor.
