LIFE CYCLES

"As you go through life, some times will be better than others; some will be very good and some will be very bad. All people experience these fluctuations in the cycle of life. There are many reasons why these cycles occur, and some can be avoided and some cannot.

One area that influences these cycles is the general curse on the world, and Satan's part in it. This can cause good things and bad...but inevitably bad, because the worldly gifts given by Satan and those that stem from evil will be bad in the long view, for they were not meant for your edification or growth—they all are meant for your destruction.

their costs as well; and depending on the origin of the pleasure, and the residual effects on others who are involved in it, will make them very costly as well.

Another result coming from evil can be illness, which is caused by direct interference by Satan, in order to make you miserable and inclined not to praise The Lord for your life; thus keeping you from a relationship with The Healer, and thereby perpetuating your misery.

Generational curses also inflict pain and suffering on the person who was born into a family who had a relative in the generations past, who sinned grievously and consistently against God; and thereby drew a deep and serious curse from God, on his/her generations to come. This is particularly unfortunate, because the people born into a curse like this had no part in the original sin, but bear the penance for it.

You will understand why this happens as you draw closely to your Creator, and He enlightens you to the full Truth. Bear in mind, there are no good gifts from Satan, nor any that spring from evil or curses.

Cycles of good generally originate from two methods of living...one where the person is in the hands of Satan, but is not threatening him by attempts of righteousness. He will keep his demons from you, if he knows that he has control, and your soul when you die; so your life may appear to be good, but underlying your success may be a terminal trip to Hell.

Secondly, good cycles will come when you are submitted to the Will of God and attempting to purify all sins in your life. As you dedicate yourself to pleasing The Lord, He will protect you from evil, and bless you in the physical, with health and prosperity. This blessing can go on for a lifetime, then continue into the hereafter, which is God's will.



However be warned, that if one is in a state of grace and turns back to sin, many more demons than were once present will be unleashed upon you, and your state will be much worse than before.

Another area that will influence these cycles is your good judgment, and the proper exercise of your God given will. Wise choices lead to a blessed life—conversely, poor choices lead to pain and penance.

As you can see, there is much that you can do to influence your life's cycles; choose wisely, for you are not the only individual effected by these cycles.
