

YOUR INFLUENCES

“On the whole you are a spirit being—the physical is just window dressing. Your spirit guides and directs you: it makes the choices, it sets the parameters of what is good and bad in your life, it provokes all outcomes of your thoughts.

The spirit receives input from many sources that all meld together to influence the thought process, and thus the final outcomes which are choices and actions. Input comes from internal and external forces, associated with the physical body. These are very strong influences on the spirit, because they come directly from sensory input from all physical senses, of which there are five that you are immediately aware of. These can be called the ruling ‘subservient influences’.



Then there are influences from the sixth sense, which is ‘spiritual touch’. Not many are aware of this sense, but it is a much stronger influencer than most realize. These inputs also impose directly on the spirit, but they are not driven by physical desire; rather by intellectual and imaginatory sources that reach for the spiritual. This influence can be called ‘ruling authoritative’, and are alive and functioning 24/7—some very strong during the sleep cycle. These influences are buried deeply in the mind, and psyche, but they are powerful, and weigh heavily on all choices and actions.

The last influence on the common human being is metaphysical, and comes from physical influences that cannot be seen or felt; but they make up the physical matrix of the existence on Earth. The original curse on mankind resides in this area, and sensory perception of this is very weak; but the influences are very strong on the human spirit, and drive it to decisions at times, that are not based on fact or what one might consider reality; but these influences are pervasive, and are everywhere in the general atmosphere of the Earth and Near Heavens.

The Creator made the human with great complexity...with the physical, the spirit, and the soul; and these all exist within the boundaries of the aforementioned influences.

Your ‘human will’ reacts to all these factors, and the resultant outcome of the assimilation of all this data, is your life and your eternity; and even though much of who you are, as a result of your choices comes from things that you cannot see, you are still fully responsible for the outcome...forever.

This is why it is so critically important to keep oneself solidly anchored to God, His Will, and His Word; for without this strong tie, the human is rarely powerful enough on his own accord to live a non-corrupt life; and corruption breeds eternal corruption in the realm of the world if not repented, forgiven, and expiated.

For those of you who think that you are in control of your lives, think again; for you have almost no control of the most important 'expose' which is the eternal placement of your spirit. To control anything in this fleeting existence on Earth, is redundant to the ultimate Vision of God for you.
