Though you cannot see this you must believe, for faith is part of righteousness, and righteousness gives you a place in Heaven. Do not feel ashamed for believing in something that cannot be seen or touched, just know that the evidence for your faith is just as real as what you can touch; and everything that is good that you see and touch, testifies of the Presence of God—everything.

Do not feel that only a belief in science makes human sense, for science is simply the instrument by which the glorious package of creation is being opened, piece by piece and item by item. Science would be the pursuit of the understanding of chaos, if it were not for the perfection of The Creator. Each year that new discoveries are made, the testimony to the perfection and order of creation is enhanced; and this will continue until the end of time.



Science is the study of God's handiwork—never forget this, for it is Truth. When science goes off the tracks is when it is polluted by man's influences, or used to justify evil. For those who pervert science, there will be special punishment, as well as for those who use it to fulfill evil desires, or to build their self-idolatry and pride. Science should be approached with great reverence, for the end of it—is God's Mind.
