LEARN TO GROW

"The troubles of the world will always be, and you will always have your share. The key to righteousness is in how you handle these. The first thing that needs to be done with any problem...is prayer. Put your problems in God's Hands and have faith that He will cover you. Then apply the wisdom that you have learned, including biblical instructions to the solution.

For many problems this will be enough, however for these problems that persist, there may be more severe remedies that must be employed. You may find curses or demons behind some problems, and if so a breaking of the curse will be necessary, or a binding and casting out of the demon.

In the case of someone involved in your problem who is not a believer, yet may be influenced by demons...you must pray fervently against the evil behind the issue, and pray for



the person to obtain freedom from the incarceration. These situations are very serious and can be difficult to change, so be a prayer warrior in any problem such as this, and the problem will be worked out in time. You may want to employ others to pray as well, for prayers tend to be cumulative and no prayer is wasted.

Persistent problems can be demoralizing and affect your faith and communion with God, so be cautious in the way that you approach any problem. Again, do not take it completely on yourself, unless of course the problem was created by you and would not have come about except for your error or misdeeds.

If this is the case, repent of the failure to use wisdom, and turn from this type of activity, and do penance such that it is not likely to occur again. Hold yourself responsible for all personal failings and you will grow in wisdom and in your spirit. Never lay blame on someone else simply because it is expeditious or freeing, for in attempting to free yourself in this way, you indeed are further enslaving yourself to repetitious sin that must be broken.

Face your failings as you would your accuser...make your case and accept the verdict standing upright in faith and holiness, accepting whatever correction that may be forthcoming with a Godly sense of childlike faith that the outcome will be good for all, because it is in the Will of God.

So many people who choose not to admit the failings of their humanity never grow to adulthood spiritually on the Earth, then must be exposed to the alternative learning realms after human death in order to be complete. This process takes much longer and it is much more painful than lessons learned while on Earth.



Remember that, all that is in the Will of the Lord will work out to be good; and your learning and righteousness is certainly in the Will of God.
