YOUR POWER IN THE FATHER

"You see what The Lord will do when intercessory prayer is pure and powerful. You have seen it change events in your realm of the physical. Yes your God does care, and yes He does hear, and yes He will act when the need is expressed in righteousness and purity...when it is in His Will.

Salvation and correction are always in His Will, and those who pray earnestly for this for others will be blessed; and these blessings go on forever if a soul is saved by the prayers said in humility and with grace, with no thought of recompense.

Your God takes your requests and gives them to The Holy Spirit, to whisper instructions to the ones involved on the Earth; and He takes your requests and gives them to angels for the physical execution of these requests. With these two powerful forces working together, God's Will is done.



Sometimes when Satan has a legal right by the Covenant to inhabit or externally influence the ones that you pray for, it makes the execution much more difficult, for the demon must be bound and the whisperings of Satan must be quieted. Therefore if your prayers are powerful enough, this power translates to force for the angels—and they can more effectively fight the demons and succeed.

This is one reason why continued prayer is so important. You have read of a case in the Word where a battle between good and evil angels lasted quite some time, and the battle was fierce. Had not the prayers of a righteous person been lifted powerfully to God, this battle could have been abandoned.

You must believe that 'the prayers of a righteous person avail much' in the realm that your eyes cannot see, and you must remember how important your prayers are. When you are on your knees for hours praying to The Trinity, you must know that not one second of your energy is wasted, and not one tear shed on behalf of another drops unseen.

Prayer is your tool by which the doors of Heaven are unlocked and opened. Even though you cannot see the effect of your prayers, they ascend to Heaven like a beam of light, and the intensity of this light is predicated on the purity of your heart, your intensions, and the intensity of the love by which you raise the prayer to Heaven. This combined with a state of



righteousness, drives the beam of light right into the Holy of Holies, and this is where God dwells.

You are not an abandoned child here in the cursed world...no you, by your own determination to draw close to your Father, have a direct line to Him, and you are surrounded by angels who protect you from evil, providing of course that you have no doors open to Satan.

You are truly a child of God with a rich and powerful inheritance and heritage, you only need to take it for yourself and live in obedience to your Father, and pursue always...purity, holiness, and righteousness.

Such is the combination that lifts you into the presence of your Father, Who is in Heaven.
