THE GIFT OF SALVATION

"Yes, I will tell you about gifts and abilities that I bestow on My creatures, and even you.

When souls, spirits, and bodies are created, each is made with particular characteristics unique to that being. Some are good and some are difficulties that require overcoming, but all that God creates is for the ultimate good of man and for their salvation and eternal peace and love.

The ones who are blessed with many gifts have great responsibilities, and have a need to rise in righteousness and holiness and stay pure of heart; for pride is the root of many sins and curses, and a person blessed always needs to stay humble, so that they do not throw away the blessings of God and become a captive of Satan through subservience to the physical and materialism.

The poor in spirit have the same requirements for acceptance by God; but God is no respecter of persons, so they must meet the legal requirements set out in God's Word, to the best



of their abilities. All must understand and live love, and retain a life of holiness, purity, and righteousness. For the poor in spirit, these requirements many times are easier to meet because they do not have the adoration of the world, and therefore the pulls of pride and idolatry that the highly blessed must combat.

All have the capabilities of receiving gifts from God, and only sin and indifference and nonbelief will keep one from realizing and acquiring these gifts. The Father opens these molecular areas of each person to function within the gift if He knows that the person will use the gift, and He closes the areas if one does not use the gift or misuses it.

So the verse in the Word that states that, "you are fearfully and wonderfully made" indeed is true; for the fruits of the gifts that all may attain are miraculous, and blend the spiritual realms with the physical.

It is eternally sad and unfortunate that so few adopt the gifts that are purposed for them and that reside within them, rather they focus on the physical realm, and consider important that which the world considers valuable, and thereby chase and hold that which is worthless in eternity and burns up in their hands as they pass from physical death to the spiritual realms.

No physical thing will save—nothing. You are saved by your obedience to the Laws of The Father, by the grace of The Trinity, and by the self-sacrifice of Jesus The Christ, for all the sins of the world.

Be aware however, that when you accept The Sacrifice and are clean and saved, if you do this with a pure heart...that any sin after salvation is not covered by Christ's Blood. Christ's Blood washes you and makes you clean, but after the washing you are justified by your holiness, righteousness, and purity; and any breach of this must be repented, forgiven and expiated, and some sins are so great that the expiation will go on after physical death in order to be approved by The Lord.



You must know this and understand this, for there are many professing Christians who believed the doctrine of the devil, of 'once saved always saved', who are in Hell or other realms of correction. You must know and accept this—there is no other way—for God will not be mocked by sin, and will not have anything impure in His Presence; so you must be completely purified prior to the judgment, otherwise you will fall into Hell.
