THE COVENANTS

"You see that when God creates, He not only makes a specific thing or being, He also creates how it will interact with all the rest of Creation...it has a 'place' within all, and this assigned 'place' cannot be altered or changed into something else, otherwise it would not be the same creation in totality. God's Plan is incorporated into all that He makes, and nothing is an afterthought—all is purposed with great thought and consideration.

Few of God's creation have been given the degree of freedom of choice and free will, as has the human race, and Satan. This freedom was great but also a risk for God, but He chose to bestow this wonderful freedom on these who He loved very much, and due to the freedom of choice—His communion and love between Himself and these creations was the pinnacle of intimacy.

His Covenant with these beings was as great as the Gift, and He allowed certain parameters to be drawn even at the first creation for these special beings, and one of the Covenants was a non-



destruction 'clause' in the Covenant for a creation period of time, which also bestowed a huge element of trust within the fabric of these beings as well.

Faith, hope, trust, love, obedience, giving, righteousness, purity, holiness, and many other attributes are inculcated within these created beings, and all this was in the wonderful package of their special creation; and God gave greatly to bring these beings into existence, for within them was the potential to reject Him...and this was a large part of the love, and trust, and the spirits thereof, that God breathed into each one of them in order to have this great communion.

God was not lonely when He created these types of beings, yet He wanted to continue to elevate His creations to levels so close to Him that He could call them children, and as with Satan—almost like a brother, because of the greatness of all that God made within Him. Satan's limitations were few, and God made him such that he understood all of Creation, and he understood the Essence of God...and no other of this type of creation had been made like this since the beginning.

He was material, and spirit, and had eternity within him, and thus could not die based on the complete covenant that was drawn at his creation. You may think of this like a living blueprint. It defined his substance, his limitations, and his existence going forward, and this Covenant was sacrosanct above all else as it concerned his being.

This is why God has not destroyed him, and this is why Satan upon realizing that he had almost unlimited power, exploited God and put himself above Him—in his mind and in his actions. So God grieved sorely over Satan, for He had created him with such profound abilities and gifted him with such great love.

So God had to limit him now that he had become evil, but that limitation had to be within the original Covenant for Satan, for God will never breach His Word, nor go against any of His promises; so Satan was cast



down to the Earth and much of his beauty was taken away and he was confined to specific realms, and any new realm that God created was off limits for Satan.

Thus as time has progressed Satan has become more and more confined, and yet within the physical realm on Earth, Satan has focused his energies to accomplish his goals that he has remaining—and the primary goal is to mock God, take as many of His creations as he can, and force them into his permanent realm of Hell...for he knows that God has engineered it such that he can never escape.

So within the time elements of the Covenant with humans, God can now terminate humanity and the Earth in its current form, and end the terrible curse; and He has readied all plans and is executing this now...yet through these preliminary actions, is warning humans through His Word and through the prophets, that the end in nigh and His warnings will continue until the End.
