COVER THYSELF

"God did not make humans to put their physical bodies on display for all to see. In the time of the Lord, all wore loose fitting comfortable clothing that shielded from the cold and heat, and thus aided in the functionality, and preservation of the body which is the temporary 'tent' that God created for everyone to shield their spirit and soul while on Earth.

The priority was and is on the spirit and soul, and not on the physical; for if one focuses on the physical, one easily falls into sin of many types—idolatry, lust, greed, perversion, desires for worldly things, froward impulses that subvert righteousness, self-adulation which dilutes the praise and worship of God, worship of the creation and not the Creator, and many other sins of a minor and major type.



Exposure of the physical imminently leads to all these, and anyone who denies it is being

dishonest or extremely naive. One is not to excite the prurient interests of another, and over exposing of the physical leads to this—absolutely.

When one participates in this, one is held liable not only for their lack of prudence, humility, and wisdom, but also any sins by others that are provoked by the behavior, and the far reaching effects of this as well. Can you see how dangerous this is to your eternal security, by allowing yourself to participate in this type of behavior, knowing that all sin must be repented, forgiven, and expiated?

Sin has many tentacles like an octopus and reaches far, and thus expiation must cover it all; and the expiation is always more severe than the sin simply because of the far reaching effects, and the expansion of people involved in the various facets and spinoffs of the sin.

All sin stands in the way of righteousness, holiness, and purity, and this is the standard necessary to enter the heavenly realms; so even a seemingly innocent display of the physical in a provocative way—is a sin. You may think that this is a bit 'puritan', but God has not changed the rules nor His Plan; and you modern day beings are held to the same standards as were people 2,000 years ago.

Just because the moral base of a country or society has changed, this does not mean that God will give more latitude in judgment for those; no...all will be judged on the same platform, and God does not 'grade on the curve'. He cannot and will not change His standards, for He is Perfect and He expects his children to strive to be like Him.

There will be aspects of judgment that vary depending on the innate capabilities of each being, but the general framework for righteousness remains, and always will remain the same. Read God's



Word to understand these standards and requirements, and take them very seriously as if your eternal environment depends of it—for truly it does.

There has not been one soul who died in the physical who has said 'I did as well as I could have'; no, all have said, 'I wish that I could have done better', for this short testing period on Earth carries extreme importance in every minute, for it all is magnified in the eternal and one small step in righteousness on Earth translates to massive steps up in the heavenly realms.

You must take each moment captive to obedience and the pursuit of righteousness, for after you die in the physical, your opportunities will be over.
