

JOY

“When you are feeling good and all seems to be going well, you feel joy. When you give to another unselfishly, you feel joy. When you have a clear conscience and harbor no hate for anyone, you feel joy. When you have self-respect and have a humble pride about who you are, you feel joy. When you are at peace with your family and friends, you feel joy. When you make healthy decisions and see good results, you feel joy. When you are diligent at work and see the results, you feel joy. When you are at peace with your Creator, you feel joy.

There is a huge difference between joy and satiation or pleasure, for joy is in the Plan of God; but satiation and pleasure is not, and many times can be considered sin. Sin never gives joy, for the two are diametrically opposed to one another, and one leads to life and the other leads to death and destruction.

Many physical pleasures seem to bring a feeling of well-being, but that feeling is transitory, and in feeding the body's desires for pleasure, the body then desires more and more to be satiated; and physical pleasure is not an end that God's Word espouses as an act that is productive in order to bring about the necessities of salvation—which are righteousness, holiness, and purity. In fact many times, in seeking for physical pleasure, purity is compromised; or if the event is significant, purity can be destroyed to the point of non-reconciliation with God.

Once purity is gone, this is one spiritual trait that cannot be fully restored. It can be forgiven, repented, and expiated, but the blemish will last forever; even if it is covered by the Blood of Jesus, and penance. A loss of purity translates to the loss of the status of 'Bride' at the Wedding Supper of the Lamb, for only those who are perfect in purity can be presented by Jesus to The Father; for the Father is out of time and can see all events of the past, and Jesus knows the Covenant Laws and does not compromise them.

Therefore you must, especially from a young age, focus on never breaching your purity; and parents, and guardians, and friends, must always instruct the young in this practice of purity, and insure that the young know the cost of losing purity...purity of thought, intention, and action. A revocation of purity is a terrible thing, and a huge loss to the being, and affects a multitude of things on Earth and in the heavenly realms.



Loss of purity causes a loss of blessings, guidance, wisdom, prosperity, peace, rewards in the heavenlies, and can cause one to go to Hell, or the realms of pain and purification, and will cause a loss of the number of heavenly realms that one has access to, if one is granted entrance to Heaven.

Purity is given by God with the assumption that it will be maintained, and never given up; but with modern man, purity is given away like an old shirt and treated as it has no value—when truly the value is great, and the loss thereof effects the being eternally.

All things good come from God, and you mock Him by not reverencing these, and deny His Majesty by throwing them away; and this is a great sin that requires great penance. Thus wisdom cries loudly to you and says, 'Hold your purity in high esteem and protect it at all costs, and always thank God for it.' Never allow the cursed world to convince you that you have no worth, and that you have full control of your body, mind, spirit, and soul; for you were bought with a price, and you belong to God if you have given your life to Jesus; or if you have not, insure that you do this now, for if you belong not to God, you belong to Satan—there is no in-between.

Live righteously in holiness and purity, and you will reap rewards eternally."
