Question – Following up on one of the previous letters (08-31-2019 JOY) dealing with the loss of purity, and not being able to fully regain it...Can a blemish that one has, due to a loss of purity, ever be completely removed?

But you will always remember your loss, and though mourning you will have peace. Draw close to God and He will draw close to you.
