The types of activities in Heaven are not limited, the only limitation is on each soul and spirit, given the realms that they are able to inhabit; but none will be disappointed with what they can do, for they know all details of how they accumulated rewards while on Earth, and all are content with their place, and there is no envy for the love in Heaven overcomes all, and there is no place for sin.

So you ask, what will 'my' existence in Heaven be like? The answer is simply, whatever you wish it to be, for your options are so immense and diverse that you will never be able to experience all of it; and bear in mind that God will always create new and wonderful things for all there.
