## SIN AND YOUR ROLE WITH IT

"Yes, there is time to repent and begin the expiation process. All those who sin need to begin this process now; for depending on the severity of the sin, the expiation may take quite some time here on Earth, and certainly in the afterlife.

For those of you who have never known Jesus, you are the fortunate ones, for when you give your life to Him you are completely cleansed and made holy by His shed blood on the cross. However for those who have previously accepted Jesus, and made a commitment to live a righteous life, then fell back into sin you have no elements of The Sacrifice by which to cover your sins after salvation.

So you must pay the whole price for your sins, and this will cleanse you, but through fire in one of the realms of punishment; or through rapid expiation while still



on Earth in the last days through accelerated expiation—through giving yourself back completely in shame and humility to Jesus and His Father.

If you are in the latter group you must fall on your face and admit all your sins, and if you cannot remember them, you must ask The Holy Spirit to bring them back to your remembrance; and for each one of them you must ask forgiveness, and accept whatever cost that you must pay. For if you are not completely cleansed by the time you resign the physical realm, you must continue to pay the full cost in the afterlife; and you are much better off suffering for your sins while still in the Curse of the world.

You cannot imagine just how important this is for your eternal future—for the cost if you fail is beyond your ability to perceive. Although you live in a Curse, forgiveness is still in residence, and God's Presence is still here with you. After leaving the world, neither is true; and you can only satisfy your repentance by paying the full cost in 'quid pro quo'. Whatever pain and suffering that you inflicted on the one who was the object of your sin, must be covered in like or similar pain; and for all who were hurt by the ripple effect of your sin, even for generations, must be requited in like suffering; and all the while you must recognize the sin, ask forgiveness, admit that you own it....without one thought of adversity, and pay the full price.

Then you must pray that the span of your sin stops, and request mercy for any who may have gone to one of the realms of sorrow as a result of your sin. This type of expiation can go on for a very long time, as the hurt soul is punished as well for their failures due to your sin-damage, and other sin as well. Do you see now how toxic sin is? There is nearly no end to it, and you must clear the slate for everything that you have done, in order to enter Heaven.

Recognize sin and fully understand what it is, and stay away from it like a coiled rattlesnake; for even the smallest sin can have ramifications that are very difficult to cure. Take your God very seriously and do exactly as He teaches you to do, and stay away from even the appearance of evil; then you will not be caught in it's trap.
