## THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS

"Father Dias is an example of My Word not properly filtering down to those who are charged to understand it and apply it. As a young priest, he has read the Bible as a mandate in his training, but he did not look at every scripture critically and apply the most stringent meaning of them to his life.

The Father is Perfect, and all of His Word must be taken as the most extreme example of the Thought; and this Thought applied in its perfection, without blemish or compromise. Father Dias however has been inculcated with the diluted doctrine of 'once saved always saved', and for those who sin...the forgiveness process is simple and easy, with the act of reconciliation.



This is not his fault personally, at this young age; however if he does not

rightly divide the Word as he grows older, he will be held liable for his infractions of the perfect application of My Word. He feels that baptism is permanent salvation, and while this is a necessary step, a person must live a life of righteousness, holiness, and purity thereafter; and if they do not, there is repentance and expiation to pay.

He believes that he has the power to bind and loose all sin from his parish, and to a degree this is true; however, the sinner must make a sincere and heartfelt confession, and truly be sorry for their failures, and truly intend to never sin again; and thereafter make their best effort not to sin.

A chronic sinner who has a hardened heart will not be forgiven, and in the most extreme case, the Holy Spirit will be so grieved that He leaves the person forever—and that means absolutely no salvation for that one. This being the case, if this person goes to a priest for forgiveness, no matter how remorseful, and no matter how holy the priest—the sin will not be forgiven and the soul will be destined for Hell.

Father Dias needs to learn that there are conditions imposed with all that he does, and these conditions are predicated on free will and free choice that humans can make: I have said several times that a human can save or doom themselves by their choices.

The holiness of the priest is a factor in forgiveness as well, for the prayers of a righteous man avail much; and when a holy priest absolves one of their sins, those sins are sent as far as from the east to the west from God, and He remembers them no more. This does not mean that the plan of expiation for these sins will be broken, it simply means that this sin will not be before the Eyes of God anymore. The expiation must continue until all sin is paid in full, otherwise that one cannot enter the holiness of Heaven.

The same is true for one outside the Catholic Church; the pattern of sin and forgiveness is the same, the difference of course is that the sinner goes to Jesus The Christ for the forgiveness; and in extreme cases asks for the intervention of the saints and the Holy Mother, and must be deep in fervent prayer for



complete forgiveness; then accept and gladly perform all expiation imposed without grumbling or seeking pity. God means for all to go to Heaven, and all He does is for your good, even the painful expiation—so you must be glad and thankful in all things.

For those who are sinners and not saved, this of course is the first step in salvation. Do this now, for the time is short, very short.
