

THE PATH OF WISDOM

“Let no one take away your sense of righteousness, truth, and character. There are many reasons why those around you have and are fallen, and none are accrued to you; so do not meet them where they are at, and so...not swim in their pool of defeat.

Stay at the pinnacle of wisdom that you have gained, and do not compromise this for an instant. God gave you these gifts to carry with you everywhere you go, not to leave in storage as you go about your life. Further, wisdom feeds wisdom, and from your highest point you can see further heights and work to attain them; but if you fall back to the valleys, you can only see that which you have already attained, and this inhibits your growth to become as God.



This is a long path and it will go on forever, but know that the closer you get to God, and the more like Him that you become...the more blessed and grand your life will be whether here on Earth, or in the afterlife. Avoid the terror of being taken by Satan by never taking the first step into sin, and if you fall repent quickly and take your punishment with thanksgiving and expiate fully, then the grace and mercy of God comes back into your life, and you move back on the path of growth and wisdom which will shield you from further falls.
