FREEDOM

"Do not fear being cursed, nor the curse, nor anything else, for I will protect you and guide you in all your activities if you remain submitted to Me; and best case scenario, you die and leave the cursed world, and on to My Kingdom that has no curses, nor anything else that is bad or of sin. Do not fear dying or the curse—fear God, for I am The One Who judges your future....and I am not referring to a short time period ahead of you, I am referring to your eternity. Trust in Me and follow My commandments, and you will not need to fear anything, you will be free to live unbridled for your King.

How does this sound to you...freedom from guilt, freedom from the consequences and punishment for sin, freedom from the evil one and his tricks, and freedom of peace in knowing that as soon as you leave this world you will be in the presence of Jesus The Christ? There is no other true freedom in all existence than this; you do not get freedom from others for it is carnal and temporal, you cannot get freedom from governments, religions, organizations, health treatments and the like, for they all end at the will of someone or something....and certainly at death; and after death is the most critical time to have freedom, for it is forever.



There are many prisons in the hereafter with varying degrees of misery and punishment, but you need not have any restriction on your freedom, just live in strict accordance with the Laws of God as expressed in the old Biblical texts. Let them rule you and consider them above and before any other rules or priorities in your life, for if you do not obey the Laws of God, truly nothing else will matter as concerns your freedom and your eternity.

Compare all that you do and all that you live by, in the mirror of the Word of God; and if it does not line up, change it, and do not follow or abide by anything that governs your life other than the Laws of God. After your obedience to God's Laws, then you can proclaim and live as you wish in accordance with as many of the tenants of the world that you can justify; but always put God first, for He is a jealous God and He will not tolerate any creation or worldly wisdom to be put ahead of Him or His Wisdom.

The reason is clear: He is Perfect, His Word is Perfect, and all else is not—and to worship the creation rather than The Creator is error and idolatry and sin, and you do not want to be guilty of these, for your mission is to become perfect even as God, so you must allow nothing



to stand in your way; and if something does block your progression to God cast it aside, for indeed all that keeps you from God is from Satan or the curse, and you do not want to be ruled by either, for it truly is servitude and leads to eternal incarceration with absolutely no freedom whatsoever.

The only lasting freedom for your mind, body, spirit, and soul is from God; and as you are 'In God' you can experience it right here in the world of curses; and as you rise to meet your Father in Heaven, the freedom that you experience would not be possible to contain in the poor human body—it is immeasurable.

Do not build a prison for your future...be obedient to God The Father and put He and His Laws first above all.
