THE DESCENDANTS OF ISHMAEL

"It went well for those warriors of peace who killed the leader of ISIS. So you see that The Lord is still with your nation, but your hold on God's Hand is slipping away because of the allowed erosion of your laws, originally set up to fairly govern your country and reflect the principles of God's Word.

There is much for you to pray about, but the predominant concern that you should have is for mercy. By their works of grace and charity individuals earn mercy and grace from God, and in their righteousness they merit even more—and God gives freely. A country is no different, and all who live in a county will be involved in any mercy or punishment that God invokes on the country.



If a country is evil and murderous at its heart and by its laws, it will be condemned in the same way that a person would be. Conversely if a country is righteous, all who reside within it will receive some of the grace and mercy bestowed on the country in general.
