If one could see behind the veil between the physical and spiritual, one would be frightened and amazed at how evil forces are always on the attack to maim, kill, and destroy, those who advance God's Plan; their goal as set out by Satan—is to kill the vessel that serves God in order to minimize their negative effect on Satan's Plan.
