SUICIDE

"No matter what your political, social, moral, or economic beliefs....you will be governed by God's Laws. It does not matter what you have chosen to validate as your belief structure nor your motives for your ultimate beliefs, you will be judged by your Creator. It does not matter whether you think that there is a Creator—you will still be judged by Him.

Nothing that you espouse changes anything in the Divine Realms, and nothing that a non-believer does will influence God's actions and His decisions. Are you getting the point? You are a creation, and you are expected to live your life in accordance with all that God has laid out many years ago; all who have lived have the same expectation, and this is why God designed all as it is, and this is why He established laws so that all His creations would know what is acceptable and what is not.



There is no ambiguity in God's Laws if read and understood correctly, and He is very specific when it comes to taking a life. You may think that just because you live within a physical being that you have full control over it, and that whatever you decide for that being is final...and that no one has the right to tell you what you should do with your physical body. This thought process is gravely in error.

There are three parts to your being: the physical, the spirit, and the soul; and you have some control over the physical and the spirit, but you have no control over the soul, and the spirit and soul are made of eternal elements and they do not die. If you kill the physical by your reasoned choice in full knowledge and in the full exercise of your will, you have done an act that is governed by the Laws of The One Who created that body; and while you reside in the body you do not own it, it belongs to the One Who made it, similar to a lease agreement.

The Word tells you that your body is the Temple of God and that you have an obligation to treat it as such; so the extinguishing of your body is in direct opposition to the One Who owns it and Who has eternal plans for it that have been set out for many years and even far beyond your conception; and that plan intersects many other plans and influences many other souls. Thus in killing your body you mock God in the highest way, and your surviving spirit and soul will then face God with the complete knowledge of what you have done, for the decision was not physical it was spiritual, and your spirit will be punished because of the terrible indiscretion and the punishment is eternal.

Where the spirit and soul go after death is very complex and is reliant on virtually millions of factors all related to your life and your intercessors, but generally the good people who



commit suicide go to the Realm of Learning if they are in God's Mercy and they suffer grievously for a very long time, yet they have a chance of going to the marginal Heaven if successfully expiated. The sinners who commit suicide go to the Realm of Knowledge if they are in God's Mercy, and the suffering there is immense and the duration is very long and most do not succeed in coming out of it and they go to Hell. For the serious sinner who mocks God with their life....they go to Hell with no chance of redemption. All of these outcomes are terrible, and anyone involved in them cry out constantly in remorse that they did not respect their Creator and live by His Laws.

Do not even entertain one thought of taking your life for it is gravely wrong. Rather rely on God to take you through this life and He will give you hope, peace, love, and blessings, beyond your imagination. This is real, this is your chance to live forever in bliss with God and all who love you.
