GUIDANCE FOR BEHAVIOR

"This would be a good day for Me to tell all children of God about His Grace and Love and how He cares for even the most insignificant one in the human population.

Many people think that as they grow in knowledge and power that they become closer to God, and that even their prayers and actions become much more influential with God, just as they are with humans. This unmistaken belief leads these types of people to idolize themselves and others in similar positions...and this of course is sin.

Many also believe that as they grow their wealth, that they too have more clout in God's Kingdom in that they can give to the causes of God and thereby make a difference. This also can lead to idolatry especially if the gifting is visible and acknowledged by others. The Word states that... we are not to have our right hand know what the left is doing, and that if men give accolades for gifts given—that this is the only reward that one will receive for giving the gift.



Recall also the story of the widow's mite and the significance of her gift and the sacrifice that she made in giving. God wants the principles of her gift applied to all gifts to God, for the worth of the gift is determined by the heart and the intent thereof. Sacrificial giving touches the very heart of God and He blesses it immensely, and those who give sacrificially take one step closer to the Gates of Heaven every time they do.

Also humility is a very powerful trait to have and to employ when working with the precepts of God, and indeed in all that one does for God, it is as important as selflessness which God also loves greatly. For one of little knowledge or power to come to God in humility and supplication is a great action, and whatever the request that is brought forth to God, it will be given priority...and if in the Will of God, will be done. This is the outward display of love for God, and if done with a true heart of mercy and grace every action avails much with God, even to the receipt of the requests in the Holy of Holies.

God loves obedience and God loves those who do not idolize themselves and others, yet who look honestly at Who God is and how great, mighty, and complex He is, then worship and praise Him because He is Love and all that is good; for if He were evil, the torment that humans would suffer would be incalculable. Remember Who your Father truly is and remember also who Satan truly is, and you will see how you have been delivered from evil by God and His Laws, Jesus The Christ, and by your own actions in obedience.

This is the path that God has set out for you and for those who follow, they will have a life of blessings while on Earth and a glorious forever while in Heaven with all other righteous. Believe these



principles and study God's Word and apply it to your life without compromise, and you will be blessed and you will be saved from evil and its eternal influences on you.

Flee from the very appearance of evil and you will be much safer than if you think that you can be among it and not be scathed, for this is not true, and certainly humans can become corrupt by their affiliations and by what enters their eyes, ears, and mouth; therefore contemplate on that which is good and on that which is holy and you will grow in the spirit and you will draw closer to God, and as you do He also will draw closer to you and you will be lifted up above the dull coercion and corruption of the world—and all around you will marvel at the change and the exhortation of your wisdom.

All this begins with the right heart of humility, selflessness, mercy, grace, and love. Make this your mode of operation and you will not fail, and others around you will be lifted up as well.
