"Yes there are many in the Realms of Correction who will not make it to Heaven, and it is by the undeserved Mercy of God that they were given a chance at salvation at all. By the Word, the strict letter of the Word, many of these souls should have been sent directly to Hell. However due to numerous factors, the least of which is not the intercession by the righteous and the saints, these souls gained the Mercy of God and were allowed to go to one of the several Realms of Correction.

The deeper areas of the realms are painful, very painful to the human body and the spirit and the mind—for God is not there; and the circumstances by which the dead arrive at these realms is well known and every infraction of God's Laws is visible and must be repented and fully expiated before any progress can be made to higher areas of these realms...and the advancements even for the truly and wholly repentant are very slow. There are those who in the times directly after Jesus walked the Earth are



just now emerging to the Marginal Heaven, and there are many who simply gave up the fight and gave themselves over to Satan.

These of course did not fully realize the extent of the torment and pain and complete distress of Hell, yet no matter how they beg for a reprieve and another opportunity, they will not get it for the Covenant is absolute in this area of law, and Hell hath no redemption and all who are there hath no redemption as well. If modern day Christians knew how, by even a series of what might be called minor infractions, that their soul can and will end up in a Realm of Correction, their lives would change dramatically, for God's Word is absolute and non-bending...it was established on principles of good, righteousness, holiness, purity, and obedience, and it cannot and will not change because of the modern notions of what 'good' is.

Good is not a malleable principle and it is not 'relative' to anything but God. He established good and He inculcated it within the fabric of all the physical and spiritual reality of man, and in man's disobedience, he has attempted to change the character and definition of good, but humans being the creation and not the Creator, have absolutely no acceptable input on the foundations of good....for God created mankind in a way that good was the governing part of their existence, and to change good would require changing humans themselves into another entity and this God reserves for other cultures elsewhere.

Good will always be static in definition to humans and they have the choice to accept it or reject it, and the perils of rejection are clearly delineated and are to be known and respected.
