

EXPIATION AND YOU

“When would you think is the best time for one to repent? Some say never. Some say occasionally. Some say immediately.

When do you say that expiation begins? Some say never. Some say occasionally. Some say immediately.

How long would you say that the sin-repentance-forgiveness-expiation cycle takes? Some say it is not a cycle. Some say that it depends on the extent of the sin. Some say that it may never end.

I will tell you this, when one accepts Christ as their Savior and Lord, all sins are forgiven and forgotten, as far as the East is from the West; and one is spiritually washed to be whiter than snow...then comes living life in the highest form of purity, holiness, and righteousness. So, are all past sins completely gone, forgotten, and expiated; and what about curses of the world or generational curses? The answer to this, is that the curses continue, but the way in which the Christian confronts them, renders a different outcome than if an unsaved one stands alone against them. One can be an overcomer, and the other will fail; even to the point of death.



And what of expiation then, for a new Christian who has had a life of grievous sin? Upon salvation, one now has a Master and Lord, full of grace and mercy; one also has the Holy Spirit to instill wisdom and comfort; and one has God The Father who can give gifts to aid in the expiation process. Upon salvation one is forgiven, but since God is a just God, all sin must be dealt with and paid for, in order for one to be purified such that they can be in the Presence of God.

For those who say that Salvation is a ‘get out of jail free card’, they are sadly mistaken. Indeed, they are saved, but not sanctified by fire. All sin must not only be washed away, such as a stain on a shirt, the stain itself, after leaving the shirt, must become nonexistent through the process of purification. Expiation does this through the striving and good works of the saved Christian; and this process never stops, until one reaches their final destination in Heaven. Even then, spiritual growth does not stop, and one can grow to glorified states that God ordains, based on the efforts of the spirit man.

For the poor soul that does not become righteous, the expiation never ends in the terrible place called Hell. Satan will constantly attempt to convince you that he, nor Hell exist; but beware, for there is much more unseen than seen in the physical realm, that humans call home.

Thus, the fewer the sins, the more rapid the glorification. Take wisdom from this.”
