## **GRACE AND HEAVEN**

"This message will be about God and His wonderful grace that He bestows on all His creations. None is without it unless one turns away from The Creator, then the light of grace fades and ultimately goes dark as is the case with the willfully disobedient.

God is in everything but His Presence can be nullified by sin and disbelief, and then the supernatural strength and protection is gone, and the evil one then sees as he prowls around that the spirit is naked and vulnerable and he moves upon that spirit to become even more evil, and with the full acquiescence of the host will possess and dwell within that creature, rendering that creature to a hopeless state of existence and doomed to Hell...unless there is powerful intercession by a Godly one, or a number of holy ones, and or by a willful turning from sin to the ways of God.

In this way it is possible to return to the Grace of God, but prior to the restoration much penance and forgiveness must occur for all the sins and the repercussions thereof...and this can take many years. Full Grace can only be restored by accepting Jesus The Christ as your Lord and Master and choosing to live 'In Him' for the rest of one's life; or in the case where one knew Jesus yet turned away...then that one must climb the long steep hill to righteousness, holiness, and purity,



and rise in love and in the spirit to the point where God forgives the willful sin and mocking of Him and His Holiness.

Many give up their position as a 'Bride of Christ' in this way, for as one accepts Jesus as Lord and Master, one forms a Covenant with Jesus and that Covenant includes a bond like a marriage...so if one remains faithful throughout their earthly life that commitment remains and the bond is not broken; but if one covenants with Jesus The Christ then breaks that Covenant, then the marriage supper will not be part of their future. When the Covenant is made, one must remain righteous, holy, and pure in order to consummate the relationship in Heaven after the earthly death; and this consummation is a process of bodily transformation and a melding with The Spirit of Christ forever.

All who are brides of Christ will be marked in Heaven and will be readily recognizable amongst all the rest, for they are pure and holy and they will see God The Father; for when The Wedding occurs, The Father's Presence is there just as a human father would be, and He 'gives the brides away' and He does it with great and righteous pride—for these are the obedient children who are worthy to have the bond with Jesus The Christ. These brides like all the rest in Heaven, can continue to grow in the likeness of God as they elevate to perfect love and strive to understand God fully, and as such may attain the structure of a 'Great Spirit' in the eras ahead and their bond with Christ gives them a component that aides in this process. However, many who have stumbled in their test while on Earth have risen to great heights because they have



humbled themselves, acknowledged their failures, and pursued God with a burning desire in their spirits and dedicated themselves to perfect Love.

All who attain Heaven have this opportunity, but for those who only attain the Marginal Heaven or the lower realms of Heaven have a much longer road ahead of them to attain greatness of spirit. I have mentioned before however, that many in Heaven are contented with their station and will not grow to greatness and these are loved dearly by God as well...they just do not have the level of communion that others do, yet they are still an important integral part of all creations in Heaven and they are all part of the existence in love.

Heaven is a marvelously complex area and it goes on and on and on, beyond the limits of the searching of any soul and spirit in Heaven, and all have their place and all are wonderfully adoring The Trinity and the perfect grace that abounds in Heaven and all are blessed mightily...so remember what you must do to be in, and stay in the Grace of God; and do not succumb to any of the petty and transitory lures of sin in the world—rather stay 'In Christ' and do not sin, and you will have eternal rewards beyond your wildest imaginations. You have complete control of your eternal future by your obedience. Do it...be it...and do not allow anyone or anything to take it away from you.
