LUCIFER THEN – SATAN NOW

"We shall learn today about the devil, Satan, the evil one, the king of Hades and Hell, the eternal exploiter of man; and all that God created for man.

He once was a favorite of God, a beautiful Cherub...and he grew in his spirit such that he gained glory from almost all who dwelt in Heaven. He was glorious to behold and he shown brightly far and wide and his wisdom and power were highly respected amongst the heavenly beings. He communed with God The Father, The Holy Spirit, Jesus The Christ, and all the Great Spirits. He was considered to be a brother to all, and he adored and glorified God; and God blessed him richly for his obedience and his desire to grow to be as God.

God communed with him...called Lucifer, in a degree of intimacy that only a few had the opportunity to do, because of his great stature and position in the Spirit. He shared God's thought, plans, and creation...and God allowed him to create many things and things were good in Heaven, and all lived together in peace and harmony. As God constantly expanded the realms of Heaven, He also expanded the living beings to inhabit these realms; and the wonders to all kept all satisfied completely with their existences, and with their relative places within God's full Creation.

This allowed Lucifer to understand much more about God and His Love and the free nature of it, and this allowed him to see that his obedience was a matter of choice—and this was a form of love. So in understanding evil yet choosing good, he could express to God a near perfect love; and this pleased God very much and thus God continued to bless him.

Lucifer tried to hide his newly acquired pride, arrogance, and lack of perfect respect for God, but God saw it and it concerned God; but for a great time He allowed Lucifer his freedom, yet continuously showered him with love and considerations such that he would continue to adore and glorify God and realize that He was the Supreme Being over all creation...a good God Who cared for all that He had created. Lucifer however, allowed the pride and lust for adoration and power to overcome him, and eventually began to sway other beings to his twisted wisdom as well and many began to doubt the sovereignty and love of God, and Heaven began to split in its adoration and service to God.



God therefore employed many of His loyal beings to monitor and influence these disobedient ones, yet with Lucifer's continuous quest for power (tainted with evil and poured out in great measure over all who would listen to him), they only became more and more rebellious. As God's patience wore thin, He gave warning after warning to Lucifer and all who were his followers, but they all considered God to be weak and flawed because in His great love He continued to allow this rebellion to occur.

Then there came a time when God had to stop the dissention in Heaven, for it was defeating His Master Plan; so He gathered all together and chose the ones who were loyal and gave them a mandate to extricate all evil from the heavenly realms, and thus the war started. This war went on for a long time in various forms, yet finally God created a realm in and around the Earth that had impenetrable borders that He isolated Satan and his followers to, and they are still there today. However, the Covenant is quickly drawing to a close and these realms will be closed very soon, and all in them will be moved to other realms that now exist for their inhabitation.

This is the story of Lucifer/Satan....see that you emulate God and not Satan, or you will receive the same fate. Take wisdom from this."
