

### SERVICE

You may serve in many ways and all your service if in love will bear much fruit, and those that you serve will be struck by the pleasant love that you display on their behalf and they may come to salvation as a result of it.***

***Jesus set Himself as an example to all people of the world, and He lived His Word perfectly. If you read and know the Word—you too can become a perfect example to all who encounter you...of the good that is in the world of curses. You can be a beacon of light to a hopeless world, you can be the hand of help that one may so desperately need; and you by your example may change lives not only here and now, but for all eternity and you may not even know it. Just like the ripples of sin, so do the ripples of love go on and on and on many times for generations; and this can start by a simple act of loving service from one to another...and this can be within a family, or without.***
