

### THE TICKLING OF THE EARS

How can one who had a responsibility for many, ever have enough time for the penance due?*

And will **indeed turn away** their hearing **from the truth,** but will be turned unto fables. **But be thou vigilant, labour in all things, do the work of an evangelist,** fulfil thy ministry. Be sober. [2 Timothy: 2-5](#)
