"What does it mean to be under the Wings of God? Does He actually have wings as the angels do, or is this just a phrase for the learning and understanding of man?

He is the essence of all things that exist, and to be under His 'Wings' is the place where all the wise wish to be; for then they have extreme power and protection from the Curse and all evil...and are free to live in the Plan of God which goes on forever and ever.



God is the ultimate power in all creation, as far as the eye can see and as far as light can travel and as far as the winds of the Spirits can move. There is no other power that pervades all, and He never ages nor diminishes—He just continues to create and grow into all that He has created, and He shares this all with His obedient beings based on their level of glory.
