## **PURGATORY DEFINED**

"Everything that is not of God, has more punishment than pleasure. Momentary pleasures are followed by decades, if not an eternity, of pain and expiation...if that pleasure is rooted in evil. Those who do not yet see this wisdom, simply have not lived long enough to pay for their sins; or cannot see beyond the veil to view the sufferings of those who are no longer in the human-physical realm.

Every sin of the flesh must be repented, forgiven, and expiated—every one. You ask, how can a Christian who dies immediately after a sinful act of the flesh expiate? The answer, for those in God's Mercy, is Purgatory. This is a place of cleansing by fire, and all those who are in the Realm of Salvation will have all imperfections cleansed, prior to experiencing Heaven. This is not elective, this is mandatory.



Heaven cannot harbor sin, and never will harbor even the smallest impurity; so in God's Mercy, He created this place where the saved can attain the spiritual level necessary to enter eternal peace. If Purgatory did not exist, very few souls would ascend to Heaven, because of human weaknesses of the flesh.

Jesus came to save us from sin, and to give us the hope of eternal life in Heaven; and when one accepts this, then one is on the path to Justification. Living a life then, of holiness, righteousness, and purity, keeps one on the path to Heaven; and for the ones who do not stray, their path ends in Heaven. For those who fall down on the way, in willful sin, need purgatory as their safety net; and most believers go there...and most are very happy to have this Mercy. Most also, do not know that it exists; so it is a surprise when it is announced. But when shown their options, and the entrance requirements for Heaven, they go gladly, knowing that if they fully expiate and grow in love, to a point that is acceptable for communion with the saints—they are free to live in peace for eternity; a small tradeoff for the Prize.

Purgatory expiations occur much slower than expiations on the Earth; so wisdom shouts to the believers to expiate all that they can, while in the physical realm.

Again, all sin must be expiated, so do not sin; and focus on cleansing all past sins. Go to God for help. He, and The Son, and The Holy Spirit, will give you all that you need to purify yourselves."
