
## **COMMUNION WITH THE FATHER**

"When you hear that The Holy Father is Supreme, what does it mean to you? Supreme means 'above all' in this form, and it is a term of distinction...distinct from all else that exists. Supreme not only means that The Father rules and is over all, it means that He controls all—in accordance with His Covenant with man, and all the spirit realms.

Still, even with this degree of blessing, humans have proven to be one of The Father's greatest disappointments, other than the devil and his angels; because they failed to rise up to meet Him, even though they possessed that ability to do so. Even to this day, humans still maintain the ability to rise in the spiritual, to a level of perfect communion with The Father; but they willfully fall short, as they are distracted by the base attractions of the flesh.

The flesh was one of the great blessings that The Father bestowed on humans; but it was not created to control the being—just as an augmentation to the joy, that the being was blessed to experience. This joy, has now been perverted to be an emotional or physical feeling that satiates the being; whereas it was created to be a complete physical and spiritual melding, into a pure form of worship and adoration of The Father. Now it is more realized as an adoration and satiation of the creation, not The Creator. This is a violation of the Commandment against idolatry, and considered to be a grave sin in the Eyes of The Father.

The Father wishes that His creations would focus on the spiritual, and rise up in knowledge and works; so that His creations again, will be acceptable in His sight and once again commune with Him, in intimacy.

You were made to have the ability to fend off evil and desires of a base nature—so do this, in honor of God The Father and be saved.
