

FAITH

“For all, there was a beginning, but there will be no end. When God creates, especially the human kind, He does not put death within them...excepting their mortal bodies. These bodies die, as back to the dust; but the incentive is given to all people of a glorified body to inhabit forever.

Thus the spirit and soul are birthed, but they lose the body; yet this third component is renewed, with few limitations, if the human is worthy. This is the Plan of God for human beings—that they prove themselves, through the curse; and succeed in righteousness, holiness, and purity; and emerge victorious over sin and the curse, to live with God in a paradise that cannot be appropriately explained, because it is so glorious.

So it is, that you people have an opportunity that no other creatures have; and you above all, are favored creations of God. Many of the spirits and angels marvel at this great gift of God; but these also are greatly distressed at the knowledge that most humans throw this great promise away, like yesterday’s garbage, in favor of base and transitory human pleasures, that are of no importance when compared to what God has offered.

Humans have a difficult time recognizing the full extent, and the fundamental reality of this promise from God, because they cannot touch, feel, or see it; and thus believing requires faith, and faith is not the strength of most humans who do not cultivate it, through study and the development of their sixth sense...‘spiritual touch’.

For those who focus on the development of their innate sense of ‘spiritual touch’, they see it grow exponentially; and as it does, they see their existences change in dramatic ways, and all for good.

Faith is a trait that shows strength, and God adores this strength in His creations; for faith is a knowing, an expectation of the reality of God, and a reliance on Him, and a trust in Him, even though the physical eyes cannot see Him. This is reaching out to God, or reaching back to God in order to receive unseen gifts and blessings.

The unseen—it is hard to accept; but this trait of faith accepted and cultivated, to the point when the unseen is just as real as that which is seen, raises one in the spirit...which brings one closer to God The Father.

This is why God blesses faith so heartily, because it is the human trait that stimulates action in the spirit realm; and one that creates treasures, that will be laid up in the spiritual realm for the benefit of the one who has faith.



Your Father wishes for you to rise out of the physical realm and move into the spiritual, as you age and mature in your spiritual journey; for it is necessary for the attention of all, that one will need to step into Heaven and commune with God.

Without sufficient spiritual connections, it is impossible for a human to move from the physical realm directly to the heavenly realms, without an intermediary stop-over to attain the spiritual necessities.

The key to attaining that which is necessary, while in the physical realm, is to always pursue righteousness, holiness and purity. Living in a state of these, will cause the learning to succeed, to a level where all else becomes spiritual and thus acceptable to God.
