

LIVE IN RIGHTEOUSNESS

“Christians who have been saved, then fell back into sin, hear Me. You of all, are in the deepest jeopardy of Hell fire. You, who have willingly accepted Jesus as your own Savior, and who believed by the Word, that He was the Son of God; you blaspheme His Name by accepting sin back in your life after having a full knowledge of the Truth.

You were washed in the Blood of Christ, and were forgiven of all unrighteousness; then after knowing the Price, you allowed sin to pollute the vessel of The Lord. This is a very spiritually dangerous situation, for now that you have fallen there is no longer the Blood of Christ covering you and your sins.

Now you must ask forgiveness for all sin, repent for all sin, turn away from sin, and restore the right spirit in you; then expiate for all sins through penance, and suffering, and righteous acts that cancel sin. There is no longer a ‘blanket’ of forgiveness, nor a broad stroke of forgiveness; rather, each sin must be paid for in full, including all ramifications of that sin on others, whether it be now or for generations. It all must be paid.



Be brave in your expiations, but have great fear for The Lord because He is Justice; and He requires justice on you. Do you see why I have said that the mistaken doctrine of ‘once saved always saved’ is the doctrine of the devil? He howls with delight when a Christian dismisses sin in their lives, for then that sin is not covered, and an unpaid sin on Earth must be punished in the afterlife; thus if the sins are so severe and abundant, then God in His Infinite Justice must cast that one into Hell.

When you leave the Earth, you must be in a state of righteousness, holiness, and purity...there will be no allowances for inadequacy; for a perfect God cannot have imperfection in His domain, and this is why you are implored to be perfect. This is not a polite request, this is a requirement; and all have the capabilities to attain it through Christ.

Open your heart to Him, and the process of redemption will start. Do penance, and love God and your neighbor, and do good works, and your redemption will continue as your sin relinquishes. This is a process, and as your expiation overwhelms your sin, the sin vanishes and it is forgiven as to redemption. Then once all your sin is gone, you then are completely redeemed and worthy of Heavenly Realms, but not before.

You must understand this, and not be of the ‘worldly mind’, which is at enmity with God. You must return to the foundations of faith, just as your forefathers did many years ago; for God and His Word has not changed. The world view and morality has changed, but God has not.

Live in righteousness. Take your eternal future very seriously now and be counted worthy, for when you cry out to God after you leave this realm, there will be no one to hear, and no mercy to be had.

Take this opportunity to attain the heavenlies and seize it, and do not let it go.
