BE READY

"You are right in assuming that the Words of The Lord will be proclaimed loudly in the time of the Calamity. The disaster will be so immense, and the distress so intense, that only those completely taken by Satan will not listen. It will be apparent to all that this catastrophe is by the Hand of God, and that it is the one that has been prophesied by those of old, and those who presently have the Spirit of God speaking through them.

The Word will be prevalent, and those who are in the Mercy of God will listen and obey. Those who have a knowledge of these events, will have the responsibility of leading these lost back to Christ and explaining Salvation to them, and the mysteries of the Heavenlies.

Therefore be strong and unyielding in speaking the Truth, and be willing to die for it. If you die for the Truth, you will be in the martyr's realm of Heaven, which is one favored indeed. So stand strong in your faith and the knowledge of the Truth, and be prepared to impart it on all that you are called to teach...and give it freely.

As you see hearts changing, be there for them, and support and encourage them; for they and you will know that time is near an end, and that they will soon be dead physically, and will be moving to the spirit realm—carrying with them the knowledge that they have just learned. They will need great faith, so display great faith yourself, and expect miracles—even perform miracles yourself, as The Spirit leads.

Also beware of the adverse forces as well, and maintain your secrecy about your affairs, and use a great amount of discretion in whom you decide to trust—for trusting in one person who is of Satan can be your demise.



This time comes quickly, so buck up in your faith and your knowledge of the Truth and be prepared to do battle with the evil forces. Know that God will win, but the cost in human souls will be great.

You can make a difference, and every soul saved— is a glorious attainment—and will be richly blessed forever.
